



Midwest Division Men's Football Championship 2018

- Buffalo, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus, Detroit and Pittsburgh will play in a league format. Each team will play each other once. Location to be decided by the Midwest Board.
- A Win = 2 points – A draw = 1 point – A Loss = 0 points.
- The seedings for the Midwest finals weekend will work as follows;
1/4 finals: 3v6 4v5 these games will be played Saturday lunchtime
1/2 finals: 1v(lowest remaining seed) 2v(highest remaining seed). These games will be played Saturday evening
Final will be played Sunday afternoon
- If a team doesn't fulfill a fixture they are automatically disqualified from the championship. (They are then eligible for the shield competition at the Midwest Finals Weekend, only if they have paid their fine.)
- A fine of \$500 will be assessed to any team that does not fulfill its fixtures, (including Midwest Finals Weekend) payable to the Midwest. The Midwest will forward \$300 to their opponent (or to the host city in regards to Midwest Finals Weekend) and retain \$200 themselves.
- Home team supplies referee.
- Team sheets and ref reports are in effect and must be submitted per Midwest regulations.
- It is expected that referees will have taken the certified referee course. (Exceptions must be approved by the Midwest Board.)
- The highest place Junior B Team after Midwest Finals Weekend will represent the Midwest, at Junior B, at Nationals.
- The highest place Junior C Team after the Midwest Finals Weekend will represent the Midwest, at Junior C, at Nationals.
